**T**he streets of Downtown Burbank will be haunted by thousands of little monsters in costume and scores of pet dogs decked out to the k-9s on October 31 from 4:00 to 7:00 P.M.

On that spooky night, kids will be trick-or-treating from store-to-store (accompanied by adults!), and dog-owners will be encouraged to bring along their favorite companion for a mutt-see howl-oween parade on the AMC Walkway. Both Downtown Burbank Halloween festivities are free and open to the public.

Here are the details:

#### Trick-Or-Treat For Kids, 4:00 To 7:00 P.M.

Parents are invited to bring their little monsters for an early evening of trick-or-treating before the bigger ghosts come out. Downtown Burbank merchants will be providing free treats from store-to-store from 4:00 to 7:00 P.M. The core area for this outdoor trick-or-treating celebration will be on San Fernando Boulevard between Magnolia Boulevard and Angeleno.



#### Pet Parade for Dogs in Costume, 6:00 P.M.

Pet owners are encouraged to bring along their favorite K-9 dressed in the Halloween spirit for the 2nd Annual Downtown Dog Parade on the AMC Walkway at San Fernando Boulevard and Palm Avenue in Downtown Burbank. Owners are asked to please register on-site by 5:30 P.M. on October 31. All well-behaved pets are welcome. Dogs must wear leashes.

## BUFFALO WILD WINGS DONATES \$1,100 TO BTAC, DISTRIBUTES FREE WINGS FOR A YEAR TO MORE THAN 250 PEOPLE

It's been a full house everyday since opening for the new Buffalo Wild Wings at 127 E Palm Avenue on the AMC Walkway. According to general manager Tom Law, business has been booming since the restaurant's debut on Saturday, September 19, and his late night happy hour has been packing them in from 10:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M. "Buffalo Wild Wings is creating a late night Downtown scene with our new happy hour," states Law. "We're full to capacity with Burbank employees enjoying the novelty of a late night hang-out before they go home."

In addition, Law's free-wild-wings-for-a-year promotion exceeded all bounds, with the first couple staking their claim 24 hours prior to the giveaway. By midnight on Sunday, the line had reached 1st Street, and was jammed with 252 hopefuls prepared to spend the night outdoors in anticipation of the giveaway at 8:00 A.M. the following day, Monday, September 21. "We only felt it right to give everyone in line free wings for a year since they had all shown such dedication," sates Law. "Our promotion only called for 100 giveaways, but it was worth it to see these people happy. We also threw in one free t-shirt per person."

Saturday's VIP reception at Buffalo Wild Wings raised \$1,100 for Burbank Temporary Aid Center (BTAC). "It gives me great pleasure to donate this money raised by the generosity of our guests, and to know that it will be going to a good cause, helping those in need in our community."
